

Personal pronouns

I	أَنَا
You (masculine)	أَنْتَ
You (feminine)	أَنْتِ
He	هُوَ
He (dual)	هُمَا
She	هِيَ
She (dual)	هُمَا
We	أَنْتُمْ

You (plural masculine)	أَنْتُمْ
You (plural feminine)	أَنْتُنَّ
They (masculine)	هُمْ
They (feminine)	هُنَّ
They (dual)	هُمَا

*in Arabic, there is singular, Dual which is refers to two and there is plural which is every number that is more than two.

Examples:

أَنْتِ فَنَان

هُوَ سَائِق

هي معلمة
نحن سعداء

*When we use personal pronouns in Arabic, the verb “to be” is expressed semantically.
